At St Wilfrid's we use Pearson Bug Club as our "trunk" reading scheme in KS1. This is a systematic, synthetic phonics based scheme with colourful illustrations which capture the children's interest and give helpful tips for parents. We supplement this with our "branch" books (from a variety of other schemes) which are banded to ensure they correspond with the "trunk" books. This gives the children a broader reading experience.

We hold information sessions for parents giving further information about the way we teach reading in school including tips and strategies to help them improve their child's reading and develop a life-long love of books. Here are 10 ways your child can improve their reading!
