## How do I know if a game is the right age?

Check with a trusted adult before you play it. PEGI ratings tell us from which age a game is suitable.



## How are online games classified into different ages?

It depends on the content of the games. Some games have bad language, violence and other inappropriate content. These games are for older users only.

# What do St. Wilfrid's children want to know about staying safe online?

## **Why are some people mean online?**

People sometimes think they can get away with it! It is easier to say mean things to someone if you can't see their reaction and you don't think you will get found out.

## **How many services can use your location to see where you are?**

Many different apps use your location. This isn't always a bad thing, for example adults might use Google Maps to get directions for where they are going. Ask for permission from a trusted adult before you let an app access your location. Check the privacy settings carefully too.
