NEW SCHOOL TERMLY REPORTS:

Starting from January, we will ensure consistent use of Class Dojo across classes and regular updates for each class. We will use the online rewards system on Class Dojo to reinforce positive behaviour choices, aligning with the personal qualities highlighted in our termly reports. This will enable parents to know when and why positive behaviour, over and above expectations, is recognised.
