

Message from the Rector

St Wilfrid's is a School which has at its heart a strong and distinctive Christian ethos. The village church is closely linked to the School and we aim to work with the staff to develop the children's Christian faith, values and spirituality and thus enable them to flourish both now and in their future lives.



As Rector I visit the school weekly to lead collective worship, and I work closely with the leadership team to plan worship which is rooted in biblical theology. I also contribute to the delivery of RE and pastorally support the children, staff and parents.

Members of the congregation are actively involved in the life of the school, particularly through the Governing body, and visit the school regularly. They also support the Community teas which are held once each half term for senior residents in the village. The school regularly comes to the church for worship and several annual Christmas events are also held in the church building. Members of the church congregation organise and run a regular 'Messy Church' after school each half term. Church activities are promoted through the school newsletter.

It is a real privilege to be able to minister to this God centered school and to be part of the St Wilfrid's family.
